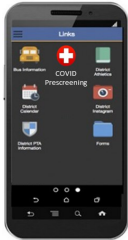




# REOPENING PLAN QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

## PRESCREENING & ENTRY PROCEDURES



All students, faculty, and staff must be pre-screened for COVID-19 symptoms. Families of elementary students can utilize an app for pre-screening and students in grades 6-12 can complete the prescreening on their own. All students will check in at designated entrances for touch-free attendance tracking and will be given a thermal temperature scan. Faculty and staff will also receive temperature checks upon arrival. Additionally, staggered start and end times will help reduce the numbers of students entering and departing at once.



## TRANSPORTATION

Masks must be worn on District-provided transportation. Students will sit one person to a seat, except for siblings.

## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)



### **Washable Face Masks**

All students, faculty, and staff will receive a custom-designed cloth face mask.

Masks must be worn in accordance with CDC, DOH, and PDE guidance.



### **Adjustable Face Shields**

In addition to masks, all students, faculty, and staff will have access to a personal face shield.



### **Clear, Personal Desktop Partitions**

All students, faculty, and staff will also receive a desktop partition that they will use throughout the day.

## INSTRUCTION

Given the significant reduction of classroom instructional time last school year, plans have been made to reteach concepts, especially in K-8 math prior to new instruction this school year. In the event of another school closure, teachers will be trained to create online content and deliver live, virtual instruction. All expressive arts in grades K-8 (music, art, physical education, guidance, and library) will be provided to students, with some being offered outside, online, or in the classroom. All grades 9-12 expressive arts are available based on student schedules.

Families who are uncomfortable with a return to school are encouraged to consider the Bloomsburg Area School District Blended Online Program, which combines fully online curriculum with live, virtual interactions with BASD faculty and staff each school day.
