PROCEDURAL REMINDERS

Paperwork: Students will receive many important documents on the first day of school that need parent/guardian and student signatures. Please complete these forms promptly and return to school by Friday, August 30, 2019.

Student Insurance: Parents are reminded that the school district does not carry medical insurance on students, but we do provide parents with the opportunity to select a primary excess group insurance plan for students. Applications are available in the main office or on the district website under the Information tab. Please read the application carefully. Parents who want to purchase the school insurance must return the completed form directly to the insurance company. Coverage can be purchased at any time during the school year.

Anti-Bullying Procedures: As noted in the Board Policy #249, complaints of bullying shall be investigated promptly, and corrective action shall be taken when allegations are verified. Additionally, it shall be the responsibility of the students, parents/guardians, and all staff members who become aware of an act of bullying to report it to the building principal for further investigation.

Health/Immunizations: Please find important information regarding health requirements below:

- All incoming Kindergarten students are required to have a physical and dental exam.
- All third grade students are required to have a dental exam.
- Students need to have all of the required immunizations. Parents will be contacted for compliance concerns.
- According to the Department of Health regulations, school districts are required to exclude students who fail to comply with requirements in a timely manner.

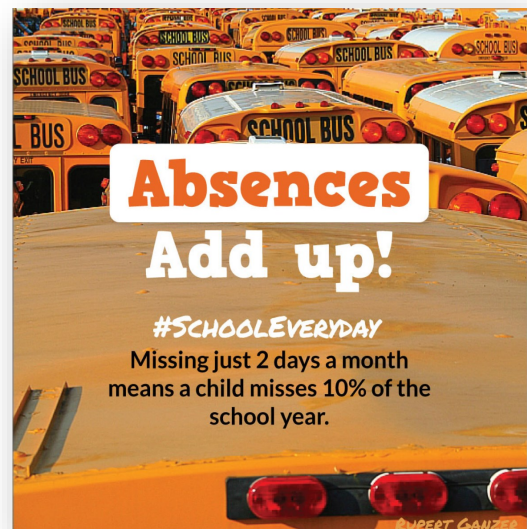
