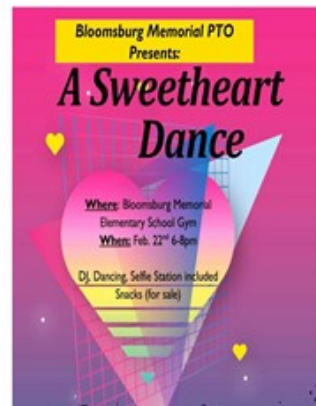
## GIRLS ON THE RUN 3/2— 5/6

Girls on the Run was designed to inspire girls, ages 8-13, to be healthy and confident; both physically and mentally. The curriculum focuses on teaching girls how to love themselves, which in turn teaches them how to love and respect others. Registration for student participants is now open for the spring season. We will be handing out flyers to the girls shortly, but wanted to also share that we are always looking for coaches. If you are interested in coaching, please contact the office. We will have volunteers helping out from Bloomsburg University to ensure that program can run here at Memorial.

- Practice days/times: Mon/Wed 3:45-5:00 p.m.
- The spring season will begin the week of **March 2nd**. Practices will not be held on days Memorial Elementary is closed.
- Coaches will teach a lesson based curriculum about self-esteem building, anti-bullying, and peer relationships for the first half of the practice and the second half of practice will be the running portion to train for a 5k at the end of the season.
- Girls on the Run provides all the supplies needed for coaches, healthy snacks for the girls, and sneakers if needed (shoe scholarship).
- The ratio is 1 coach to 8 girls.
