Title: CAREER PREPARATION INSTRUCTION

115. CAREER PREPARATION INSTRUCTION

- .1 The Board shall provide a program of instruction to prepare students for gainful employment as workers or technicians, or semiprofessionals in recognized occupations and in new or emerging occupations.

- .2 For purposes of this policy career preparation instruction shall be defined as any form of education other than college preparatory instruction that is given in a school or elsewhere, the purpose of which is to fit an individual to pursue effectively a recognized profitable employment, whether pursued for wages or otherwise.

- .3 The Board will support a program of career preparation instruction, which shall include:
 - .31 appropriate courses of study as part of the regular curriculum of the school.

 - .32 attendance at the Columbia-Montour Area Vocational-Technical School, and participation in a cooperative program of vocational development.

 - .33 career education at all levels of the school district.
