Title: SUMMER SCHOOL

124. SUMMER SCHOOL

- .1 It is the policy of the Board that the district will conduct a summer program of remedial and enrichment instruction for resident students of this district, plus such other students as the Board may admit when deemed appropriate.
- .2 In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board will make available appropriate staff and facilities. First preference will be given to district teachers who are certified and qualified to teach courses offered.
- .3 Students eligible for the summer school of this district shall include:
 - .31 resident students eligible for regular attendance in the public schools of this district; and
 - .32 nonresident students whose age or grade level is appropriate to the course of study applied for.
- .4 Tuition fees may be charged to cover summer school expenses.
- .5 With regard to transportation, the Board does not accept responsibility for any student.
- .6 Regulations for the operation of the summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of this district.
