211. STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

- .1 The Board recognizes the need for insurance coverage for unforeseen accidents which may occur to students in the course of attendance at school or student participation in the athletic and extracurricular programs of the schools.
- .2 The Board will provide parents with the opportunity to purchase insurance coverage, at no cost to the Board, for injury resulting from accidents sustained by students in schools, or school activities, according to the limitations of the coverage purchased.
- .3 The Board will maintain insurance coverage by a qualified insurer over and above the first responsibility of family coverage, and at no cost to the student, for injury resulting from accidents sustained in the course of participation in approved interscholastic athletics, band, and cheerleading.
- .4 The Superintendent, or his/her designee, shall
 - .41 prepare specifications and secure suitable coverage from qualified insurance carriers for recommendation and Board consideration.
 - .42 notify all students, and parents of students who may be eligible for insurance.
 - .43 ascertain that where the Board assumes the full cost of insurance each eligible student is properly insured.
