212. REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS

- .1 The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of the whole child. It recognizes its responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare and progress in school. It also recognizes the effects of state board regulations and federal regulations governing school records.
- .2 The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting student progress which shall include written reports at each grade level, and parent conferences with teachers where appropriate, and shall require all appropriate staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility.
- .3 The Superintendent in conjunction with appropriate professional staff members shall develop procedures for reporting student progress to parents or guardians which
 - .31 utilize effective methods of reporting appropriate to grade level and curriculum content.
 - .32 insure that both student and parent receive ample warning of a pending grade of “failure”, or one that would adversely affect the student’s status.
 - .33 enable the scheduling of parent-teacher conferences at such time as will ensure the greatest degree of participation by parents.
 - .34 specify the issuance of report cards on a quarterly basis.
 - .35 insure the continual review and improvement of methods of reporting student progress to parents.

.36 comply with the requirements of Section 7.01 of the professional employees' bargaining agreement.
