Elementary Level Mask Compliance (K-6): Students will wear a face mask at all times when indoors. Teachers may provide a mask break in classrooms, when the classroom environment aligns with CDC, DOH, and PDE guidelines. The layout and class size of our elementary and 6^{th} grade classrooms will allow for discretionary mask breaks in the classroom at the direction of the teacher.

Elementary schedules have been modified so that students can take a 10-minute mask break outdoors each hour. Sixth grade teachers will work with building administration to ensure access to common space outdoors, and indoors should poor weather necessitate.

Elementary students who do not comply with Elementary Mask Rules will be in violation of the BASD District Dress Code Policy. Teacher discretion will be used for younger students who struggle with mask wearing and every effort will be made to work with our families to promote the health and safety of all faculty, staff, and students through proper mask wearing.

Noting our BASD Board Policy #221: Dress and Grooming:

The Board has the authority to impose limitations on students' dress in school. The Board will not interfere with the right of students and their parents/guardians to make decisions regarding their appearance, except when their choices disrupt the educational program of the schools or constitute a health or safety hazard.

Students may be required to wear certain types of clothing while participating in physical education classes, technical education, extracurricular activities, or other situations where special attire may be required to ensure the health or safety of the student.

The building principal or designee shall be responsible to monitor student dress and grooming, and to enforce Board policy and school rules governing student dress and grooming.
