 - PPE and disinfecting supplies are available to staff. As staff need more PPE and disinfecting supplies for their classroom or office, they will enter a maintenance work order to request such.
 - Custodians will disinfect bathrooms and high-touch surfaces throughout the school day.
 - The district will encourage students and staff who are sick to remain home.

 - In the case of a school closure, the district will continue to offer lunch to students as needed. Technology devices are available should we need to go fully virtual, and remediation will be available for students as needed.
