- Reviewed history of partnership with district over the past several years
- Review of projects completed for the district
- Gave background on solar projects completed for other school districts
- Review of the grant opportunities available at the federal and state levels
- Focus discussion on ground-mounted units located at W.W. Evans Elementary School
- Options for purchasing discussed
- Proposed timeline presented

Solar Panel Presentation from SunPulse Solar

- Discussion of design was based on roof-mounted panels at each of the facilities
- Review of the process of installing the roof units
- Review of possible schedule and timeline
- Estimated project cost for project \$4.2 million
- Financial matrix and options presented
- Project summary presented with system details

#### Tennis Court Proposal

- Continued discussion on tennis courts
- Minutes from May 18, 2009 had approval of the district payment of \$20,000 toward the renovation of the tennis courts
- Committee recommends proposing a payment of \$30,000 to the town of Bloomsburg once the renovations are competed with the following understanding/stipulations:
  - Lights will be included in the project
  - Exclusive use of facilities for practice and matches for the fall and spring seasons

- o 10-year agreement

Middle School Sound System Repair

- Discussion of priorities for facility improvements
- MS gymnasium sound system on of the top priorities (goes in and out during events)
- Option proposed was to address the \$15,000 line item in the budget with the decrease from the Vo-tech budget in the same amount (this would not change our overall budget as presented to the board last month)

Wrestling Mat Replacement

- DKI profit discussed as option to offset cost of new mats
- 2021 (\$2,029.47)/2022 (\$4,296.39)/2023 (\$4,897.99)
  - o After all bills and costs are paid in full
- 7-piece mat that is easier to handle and will eliminate need to borrow from other districts
