**School Board Meeting Summary**  
**10 October 2022**

**Bloomsburg Area Secondary Complex Enhanced Learning Center & Zoom**

The following is a summary of the 10 October 2022 school board work session:

- Heaven Reinard made a presentation on the middle school intervention program.
- Nicole Del Gotto made a presentation on events going on at Memorial Elementary School and highlighted the work that Amelia Blackledge has done for the district during her time working and also volunteering in the district, to include work as a paraprofessional, volunteer coordinator, crossing guard, Mrs. B.'s Book Club, and with the Scholastic Book Fair.
